THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Belief in one God in three Persons is one of the most distinctive elements of Christianity. The existence of the Trinity is a dogma of our faith, revealed to us by Jesus Christ. There are many places where Jesus speaks of His Father as a separate person. At the baptism of Jesus, the Trinity is made manifest: the Son of God stands on the bank of the Jordan, God the Father gives Him His approval and the Holy Spirit, appears in the form of a dove (Luke 3, 22-23). Before Jesus ascended into heaven, he said to the apostles these important words: "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit" (Mt 28, 19).

THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi will be celebrated on Sunday, June 23rd. After the 11:00 a.m. Mass, there will be a procession to four altars set up on the side streets around the church. The procession will end at the Credit Union parking lot. We cordially invite parish organizations and First Communion children in their Communion outfits to participate in this solemn procession. We invite the First Communion girls in white dresses to serve as flower girls.

MOTHERS' GROUP

PEREGRINATION OF THE STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA

BAPTISM CERTIFICATES

We ask parents whose children were baptized outside our parish (in Poland) and will receive the sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation in 2020, for the preparation of baptism certificates needed to receive the sacraments.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

We would like to remind you that there are two ways of receiving Holy Communion: into your mouth or hand. The Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist, we receive to an open left hand (not to fingers), and we put it in mouth with a right hand in front of a priest or an Extra Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion. You can not go with the Communion in your hands to the bench. Before receiving Holy Communion, one must kneel or bow his head to worship Lord Jesus Christ.

Who can go on a pilgrimage? Anyone who feels strong can go on a pilgrimage. However, we do not encourage older people, people with a heart conditions or very small children to make pilgrimages. Young people under 19 can go on

pilgrimage only after obtaining the written consent of their parents or guardians. What are you doing during your pilgrimage? Each day is filled with a rosary prayer, a conference, testimonies of the leaders and participants of the pilgrimage, singing and conversation. Presence at the morning Mass is obligatory. In the evenings there is a time for bonfire, singing and playing, sometimes even a football match.

PARISH HALL FOR RENT

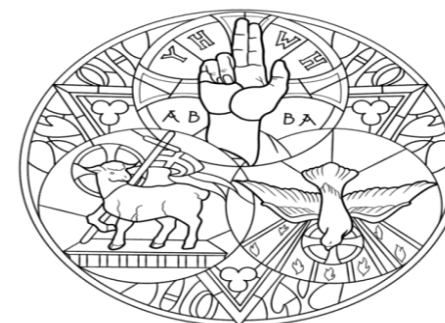
