# COVERING OF THE CROSS

The custom in the catholic Church is to veil the cross before first vespers or the vigil Mass of the Fifth Sunday of Lent while others limit this veiling from after the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

Crosses are unveiled after the Good Friday ceremonies. All other images are unveiled shortly before the Mass of the Easter Vigil.

The veils are usually made of lightweight purple cloth without any decoration.

The custom of veiling the images during the last two weeks of Lent hails from the former liturgical calendar in which the Passion was read on the Fifth Sunday of Lent (hence called "Passion Sunday") as well as on Palm Sunday, Tuesday and Wednesday of Holy Week, and Good Friday.

For this reason the period following the Fifth Sunday of Lent was called Passiontide. A remnant of this custom is the obligatory use of the first Preface of the Lord's Passion during the Fifth Week of Lent.

# HOLY MASS IN THE INTERNET ONLINE

Mass - In view of the requirements of the Government of Ontario, during this medical emergency, beginning Tuesday, March 17, 2020, all public Masses be cancelled, both during the week and on the weekend. The priests of the archdiocese will celebrate Mass every day privately for the intentions of the people.

# CARDINAL COLLINS RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING HOLY WEEK AND EASTER

We are approaching the most sacred time of the year. It is essential that, in every parish in the diocese, the ceremonies of Holy Week and Easter proceed even though adapted to the restrictions required at this time. Due to the current pandemic, the liturgical celebration of the paschal mysteries of Holy Week, the Triduum and Easter will be celebrated without the physical participation of the faithful. The following instruction outlines how these liturgies are to be celebrated in the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael, and in all parish churches throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto. Religious communities are to determine for themselves the most appropriate ways to proceed, but are to model their liturgies on what is set here for parishes.

PALM SUNDAY

### Palm Sunday - Sunday, April 5, 2020:

At the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael: The liturgy of Palm Sunday will begin at 10:00 am, and will be livestreamed so that the faithful may prayerfully unite themselves in their homes to celebrate the liturgy. The liturgy will commence with the blessing of palms, the proclamation of the Gospel and the Solemn Entrance, but without the procession of palms. Blessed palms will be distributed at a later date. Present at the liturgy will be the priests of the Cathedral parish. The liturgy will proceed in the usual way.

# THE MASS OF CHRISM

# The Mass of Chrism - Tuesday, April 7, 2020:

At the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael: The Mass of Chrism will begin at 10:00 am, and will be livestreamed so that the clergy, religious and lay faithful of the archdiocese will have an opportunity to prayerfully unite themselves in their homes to the celebration of the liturgy. Present at the liturgy will be the priests of the Cathedral parish. The liturgy will include the blessing of Holy Oils, which will be distributed at a later date.

# HOLY THURSDAY

The Mass of the Lord's Supper - Thursday, April 9, 2020 At the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael: The Mass of the Lord's Supper will begin at 7:00 pm, and will be livestreamed so that the faithful may prayerfully unite themselves in their homes to celebrate the liturgy. Present at the liturgy will be the priests of the Cathedral parish. The washing of feet will be omitted. At the end of the Holy Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed in the tabernacle. There will be no procession to a special place of reposition.

GOOD FRIDAY

#### Good Friday - April 10, 2020

At the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael: The Good Friday Passion of the Lord will begin at 3:00 pm, and will be livestream so that the faithful may praverfully unite themselves in their homes to celebrate the liturgy. Following the special decree of March 19 from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, special prayers will be said "for the sick, the dead, for those who feel lost or dismaved."

#### HOLY SATURDAY

#### The Easter Vigil - Saturday, April 11, 2020

At the Cathedral Basilica of St. Michael: The Easter Vigil will begin at 7:00 pm, and will be livestream so that the faithful may prayerfully unite themselves in their homes to celebrate the liturgy. At the Solemn Beginning of the Vigil, the lightning of the fire is omitted. The Paschal Candle is to be lit in the sanctuary. The procession with the Paschal Candle is omitted.
