#### IMPLEMENTATIONS IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF TORONTO AMID THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

#### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

All those who wish to receive the sacrament of reconciliation should contact a priest. The sacrament is to be celebrated not in a confessional but rather in another location, where confidentiality may be ensured and where the distance required by the health officials can be maintained.

#### THE 54 DAYS ROSARY NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF POMPEII FOR THE END OF PANDEMIC

We cordially invite you to pray the Pompeian Novena together on the Internet TV [www.kazimierz.org](http://www.kazimierz.org) during the week at 7am, 1pm and 7:45pm; on Sundays at 7pm, 12pm and 7pm. The novena can also be said privately at any time before the Figurine of Our Lady of Fatima via parish television, which will be on from 7am to 7pm.

#### How to pray the Novena

The Novena to Our Lady of Pompeii has two parts: Three novenas of the prayers of the 15 mysteries of the Rosary in thanksgiving (3 x 9 days = 27 days) will start May 18<sup>th</sup>. Before the beginning of each 5 mysteries of the Rosary, we say: "This Rosary I pray for You, Queen of the Holy Rosary." During part 2, the thanksgiving, every day we pray 15 decades of the Rosary (Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious mysteries), regardless of whether or not the request has been granted yet (without missing a day). After completing each part of the Rosary, we say every day:

"Hail, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, my Mother Mary, hail! At thy feet I gratefully kneel to offer thee a Crown of Roses, snow white buds to remind thee of thy joys each bud recalling to thee a holy mystery; each ten bounds together with my petition for a particular grace. O Holy Queen, Dispenser of God's graces and Mother of all who invoke thee! Thou canst not look upon my gift and fail to see its binding. As thou receive my gift, so wilt thou receive my thanksgiving; from thy bounty thou hast given me the favour I so earnestly and trustingly sought. I despaired not of what I asked of thee, and thou hast truly shown thyself my Mother. "After each of the 5 mysteries of the Rosary, during the whole novena, we pray: "Queen of the Holy Rosary, pray for us." In history there are many testimonies about graces which people have received through this novena.

#### Prayer of thanksgiving starting May 18<sup>th</sup>

"Here am I at your feet, O Immaculate Mother of Jesus, who delight in being invoked as Queen of the Rosary of the Valley of Pompeii. Rejoicing in my heart, my soul overwhelmed by the most ardent gratitude, I return to you, my generous Benefactress, my sweet Lady, the Queen of my heart, to you who have truly shown yourself as my Mother who so dearly loves me. In my laments you heard me, in my afflictions you comforted me, in my anguish you gave me peace. Sorrows and the pains of death were besieging my heart, and you, O Mother, from your throne in Pompeii, by your compassionate gaze, offered me relief. Who has ever turned to you with confidence and has not been heard? If all the world only knew how good you are, how compassionate with those who suffer, all creatures would turn to you. May you for ever be blessed, O Sovereign Virgin of Pompeii, by me and by everyone, by humanity and by the Angels, by Heaven and by earth. Amen. Glory be to the Father. Hail, Holy Queen."
