THANKSGIVING DAY

THANKSGIVING (Monday, October 12th) has been celebrated in Canada since the eighteenth century. However, it had been celebrated by different cultures of the world much earlier. Initially, as an expression of gratitude to God for the harvest and health in the family and then as a form of thanks to the natives who helped the pilgrims survive the first winter in the new American continent. Rosary Devotions...October is upon us, the month dedicated to the Rosary. In our parish, Rosary devotion is held every day at 6:15 pm; on Sundays at 6:00 pm.

RULES IN THE CHURCH DURING THE PANDEMIC

In the regard of the reopening churches decision, the Archdiocese issued several guidelines that must be in place to ensure the safety of all participants in the Holy Liturgy.

- We encourage you to use a personal disinfectant before entering the church.
- The guidelines strongly emphasize any individual attending Mass to wear a mask, and only partially remove the masks when receiving Holy Communion.

- To provide the church with the required distance of 2 meters between liturgy participants, seats in the pews are marked with green tape to indicate where to sit.
- During Holy Communion, everyone will come out of their pews in turn, including those who do not receive the Eucharist. While going up to receive communion and keeping a distance of 2 meters, we head toward the minister. stand in the designated place before the priest and after the words "Body of Christ" we answer "Amen". Then, with stretched out hands we approach and receive Holy Communion. Until further notice, this will be the only form of acceptance of Holy Communion. Those who do not receive the Eucharist will still walk in procession, crossing their arms on their chests to receive a blessing.
- To increase the number of people we ask families from the same address to come to Mass together, as members of the same household are not required to maintain 2 meter social
- Offerings will be collected after Mass to the offertory baskets at the exit of the church.
- After Mass, please do not gather for social purposes in the front of the church.
- If you feel sick, e.g. has a fever or any other symptoms potentially related to COVID, please stay at home.
- The parish office will be closed to the further notice, but you can call to leave the message or send an email to parafia@kazimierz.org

We hope that very soon everything will return to normal and we will enjoy participating in the Eucharist without any restrictions.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

The Sacrament of Confirmation in our parish will take place on Saturday, October 31st at 4 p.m. It will be a Sunday Holy Mass. The sacrament of Confirmation will be given to young people by the parish pastor Janusz Blazejak OMI. Confession for young people and their parents before the Sacrament of Confirmation will take place a week earlier, on Saturday, October 24th at 10 a.m. in the parish hall. After the confession, there will be a rehearsal in the church. Presence is mandatory.

ALL SOULS INTENTIONS

November is a time of prayer for our dearly departed. We recall those who have left to be in God's Kingdom: our parents, siblings, relatives, friends, clergy, neighbors and all those whom we encountered in our lives and to whom we owe a debt of gratitude. In our prayers we offer them up to God's Mercy. In addition to our private prayers and Mass intentions, the Church has a tradition of Remembrance Intentions (wypominki) dating back to 993. Saint John Paul II teaches us that "It is important and proper to pray for the dead because, even if they died in grace and in friendship with God, perhaps they still have need of further purification to enter into the joy of heaven." One of the forms of help we can offer them is through wypominki – where we list the names of our departed family and friends on special remembrance envelopes and the Church community prays for them. Oblate Fathers residing at the Provincial House in Toronto celebrate 30 Masses in November in the intention of all those listed on remembrance envelopes.

November 1st: Feast of All Saints. We pray for all the faithful departed and remember our loved ones who have passed away. All Souls Day: On November 2nd the Church prays for the souls in Purgatory. We believe that following purification in Purgatory, these souls will also be rewarded with Eternal Life. We can help them in their journey by offering Mass intentions and prayers for them. All are invited to join as we pray for the faithful departed each day from November 1st to November 7th. You may print the names of those you wish to pray for on the All Souls envelope and drop it off in the basket in front of the altar or at the office. All Souls Envelopes are at the back of the church. Due to the pandemic and the limitations of the Ministry of Health on the number of congregations, prayers in cemeteries on the occasion of All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day will not be held this year. Please privately go to the cemetery at any time and pray for the deceased.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation cannot be held in a confessional but rather in another location, where confidentiality may be ensured and where the distance required by the health officials can be maintained. Sacrament of Reconciliation during a week is available at 7: 30 a.m. and from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Knights of Columbus room; on Sundays, 1/2 an hour before each Mass.
