INDULGENCE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Due to the pandemic, the Holy See changed this year the conditions for obtaining a plenary indulgence for the dead related to the celebration of All Saints. A plenary indulgence for the deceased can be obtained on any 8 days in November (they do not have to be consecutive) by visiting the cemetery and praying for the deceased and by fulfilling the normal conditions of the indulgence.

**Conditions for obtaining a plenary indulgence for yourself or for one deceased person:** the faithful can receive a plenary indulgence given that they: visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased (Our Father, Glory Be), pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, go to confession and receive Communion and be free of attachment to sin. The indulgence can only be offered for the deceased. The faithful can receive a partial indulgence until the end of November.

THE ANNUAL MASS ATTENDENCE COUNT

The annual Mass attendance count took place in our parish on **October 16/17 & 30/31, 2020**. The results provide an accurate profile of Mass attendance in our Archdiocese. This year we counted 672 parishioners; 1,232 parishioners in 2019 and 1,230 parishioners in 2018.

MEMORIAL MASS

November is a time of reflection on life and death. This great mystery, which is the transition from the earthly journey to eternal life, fills us many times with sadness and even fear. The Risen Christ comforts us, assuring us that a more beautiful life in the Father’s House awaits us behind the gate of death. On Sunday, November 29<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. a special Mass will be celebrated for those who died from our families in the past year. After the Mass there will be a rosary for the deceased. We encourage parishioners to send us photos of the deceased person: mother, father, husband, wife, brother, sister or child, which we will display during the rosary for the faithful departed.

CATHOLIC FAMILY CLINIC

A Catholic Family Clinic is being established at our parish. The clinic will provide free help with marital, family and upbringing problems. The meetings are individual and will be held twice a month, on Thursdays. The meetings will be led by dr. Waldemar Paliga. To arrange an individual meeting, please call the parish office. Let us remember that although, from the human point of view, some things seem impossible to fix or change, but nothing is impossible for God !!!

MASS INTENSIONS FOR 2021

**Mass intentions for 2021** may be requested in the parish office. We remind all parishioners that each family may request up to four Mass intentions per year, of which only one can be celebrated on a Sunday. **Intensions can be requested in person only at the parish office.**

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation cannot be held in a confessional but rather in another location, where confidentiality may be ensured and where the distance required by the health officials can be maintained. **Sacrament of Reconciliation during a week** is available at 7: 30 a.m. and from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the Knights of Columbus room; on Sundays, 1/2 an hour before each Mass.
