LENT - TIME OF PRAYER AND PENANCE

As we look upon the Crucified Savior, who has renounced everything and sacrificed his life for us, let us make an effort of voluntary penance as a restitution for our sins. Let's make meaningful resolutions and refrain from participating in extravagant pastimes (sometime intentionally organized for our children and youth), from drinking alcoholic beverages, and smoking cigarettes, in order to compensate God for our sins of drunkenness, promiscuity, foul language, dishonesty, and lack of humility. In order to experience the holy time of Lent in a deep and meaningful way, our parish offers the Passion Liturgies.

LENTEN LAMENTATION & WAY OF THE CROSS

We invite everyone to our traditional Polish Lenten devotions: the **Lenten Lamentations** will be held every Sunday at 6:15 p.m. and the **Way of the Cross-every Friday** at 6:30 p.m. follow by the Mass at 7:00 p.m. in Polish. Christians, who devoutly participate in the Way of the Cross, are granted a plenary indulgence.

ACTION OF SOBRIETY

Finally, let us embrace Lenten sobriety with more courage. The Church calls us to individual and community prayer for sobriety, so that there are no people and families among us who suffer from alcohol, smoking, and drug addictions. A Book of Sobriety is placed beside the Altar of Relics. Individuals and families are encouraged to sign their names as a pledge to take up abstinence during Lent

THE FEAST OF ST. CASIMIR

March 4th, we celebrate the Feast Day in honour of St. Casimir. Due to the pandemic restrictions, we can not fully celebrate. Let us recommend our families and ourselves to the care of St. Casimir.

ST. CASIMIR

St. Casimir was born in 1458 in Krakow, a prince of Poland, the second son of King Casimir IV and <u>Elizabeth</u> of Austria. He participated in God's plans wholeheartedly by praying, studying, and helping the poor. At the side of his father he took an active part in political life. A devout worshiper of the Eucharist and of the Blessed Virgin Mary, he devoted much time to prayer and helping the poor. After a long-term lung disease, he died in Grodno at the age of 23. He was buried in Vilnius and there are his relics in the cathedral.

DEVOTIONS

This week is the first Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the month. The first Thursday - we pray for a vocation to priesthood and religious life. First Friday of the month - occasion to go to confession from 6pm to 7pm in the parish hall, and the first Saturday of the month - a day dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The first Friday devotion and the Way of the Cross-will start at 6:00 p.m.
