The Masses at the St. Casimir's Parish are celebrated daily at 8 am and 7 pm; on Sundays 9:30 am in English & 11 am, 1 pm and 7 pm in Polish through the Parish TV www.kazimierz.org and YouTube. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy starts at 3pm and Rosary at 4pm & 5pm daily.

PALM SUNDAY

Today's Palm Sunday introduces us to the mystery of Holy Week. Just as the Lord Jesus entered Jerusalem, He comes to everyone today and strengthens us in this difficult time of the pandemic. The palm trees at the entrance to the church are already blessed. We make offerings for palm trees to the treasury box.

Through the liturgy of the Sunday of the Passion, we enter the celebration of Holy Week, which leads us from the spectacular, magnificent triumph of Easter, the triumph of the Resurrection - victory over sin and death. The intellect becomes helpless in the face of faith in an event.

The Holy Triduum of the Lord's Passion and Resurrection is the climax of the liturgical year and Holy Week. It includes the liturgy of the Lord's Supper, celebrated in the evening on Holy Thursday, the Good Friday liturgy of the Passion, and the most solemn and most beautiful of all the liturgies of the Church - the Easter Vigil celebrated after dark on Easter.

Easter Triduum...

Holy Thursday: The Mass of the Lord's Supper is the gateway of the Paschal Triduum, which must be crossed in order to understand the meaning of Christ's passion, death and resurrection. It is celebrated in the evening and has a very sublime tone. All priests who serve in the parish will celebrate it. Before the Liturgy of the Word, we sing Glory to God, a hymn we have not sung for the 40 days of Lent. The performance of this song of praise of God is very important and takes place with the accompaniment of the church organs. On Holy Thursday, we commemorate the establishment of the Eucharist and the Sacrament of Holy Orders. Mass of the Last Supper will start at 7 p.m. and will be preside by Fr. Alfred Grzempa OMI. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be held until 12:00 midnight.

Good Friday we remember and live out the passion and death of Christ on the cross. It is a day of penance and strict fasting for the whole Church. It must be noted, however, that it is not a day of mourning, but a celebration of the victorious death of Christ who overcame sin and death by the power of his sacrifice. That is why we talk about the blessed and glorious Passion of the Lord Jesus. On this day, according to ancient tradition, the Church does not celebrate the Eucharist and other sacraments, except for the sacrament of penance and the anointing of the sick. Only the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is celebrated, which is characterized by seriousness and austerity and emphasized by the church's decoration. The altar is bare, which means that no Holy Mass will be celebrated today. The red color of the liturgical vestments does not indicate Christ's blood and martyrdom as much as his royal dignity and victory achieved by His passion. Liturgy of Lord's Passion in English will start at 5:00 p.m., in Polish at 3:00 and 7:00 p.m. Adoration at the Lord's Tomb will be held until 12:00 midnight. The Good Friday Collection: Our mission is to support the Christian Communities of the Holy Land, apostolic and social works and the upkeep of the Holy Sites. Envelopes are in the yearly sets and at the back of the church.

On Good Friday, we are obliged to observe a strict fast. This means that we abstain from meat. Adults can have three meals that day: one full and two light meals.

Holy Saturday is a day when the Church stands by the tomb of the Savior, in silence and concentration pondering the events of Good Friday – the saving passion and death of Christ. Since the first centuries, Christians refrained from celebrating the sacraments on this day, especially the Eucharist. They did not even gather for community prayer, so as not to disturb the silence and reflection of this special day. Instead, they tried to find time to ponder the magnitude of Christ's love who accepted the cross for human salvation. Blessing of Easter food baskets will take place from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the church hall. Easter Vigil Liturgy will start at 7:00 p.m. in Polish and English.

Easter Sunday: Resurrection Mass will be at 6:00 am; Mass in English at 9:30 a.m. There will be no evening Mass.

Easter Monday: Masses in Polish at 9:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m. & 7:00 p.m.

On Sunday, April 11, we celebrate the Sunday of Divine Mercy. The Novena to Divine Mercy will start Friday, April 2 and will end on Saturday, April 10. We pray the Novena privately either in church or at home.

SACRAMENTS OF FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION

Dear parents,

Unfortunately, due to the long closure of the churches, there is not enough time until the holidays to conduct a program to prepare children for the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation. The classes preparing children for the First Holy Communion in Polish and Confirmation in English will start on September 11, 2021 and will take place on Saturdays from 9: 30 am-11: 00 am. For children preparing for First Communion in English, the classes will start on September 14, 2021 and they will be held on Tuesdays from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

There is also a second option to prepare children for First Holy Communion in Polish and in English during the holidays (two groups); preparation within 10 days in the afternoon hours (from July 5 to 16, 2021, Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm). All classes will be conducted with all Covid restrictions, i.e. disinfection, masks and distance. Due date for the registration is until end of March.
