### THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Today we are faced with the greatest mystery of faith, which says that there is one God in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Let us try to understand this truth not so much with the mind as with the light of faith, because it is not about understanding, but about the mystery of love that binds the Divine Persons and in which we also have our place.

At the baptism of the Lord Jesus, the entire Holy Trinity is revealed: the Son of God stands on the shore, God the Father testifies to Him with His voice, and the Holy Spirit appears over Jesus in the form of a dove. Before the Lord Jesus ascended to heaven, He told the Apostles these significant words: "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." When Christ announces the sending of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, He says: "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Comforter." "The Comforter, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, He will teach you everything."

#### JUNE – MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The month of June is the month dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Sometimes we ask ourselves: What can we do for the Heart of Jesus, how to respond to His love? "Looking at the Heart of Jesus, the human heart learns to know the true and only meaning of one's life, learns to guard against the weaknesses of the human heart, connecting filial love towards God and love of neighbor. Thus - and this is the true satisfaction that the Savior's Heart expects - on the ruins of hatred and violence, the civilization of the Heart of Christ will be able to arise." Pope John Paul II. We invite you to the devotion of the Heart of Jesus every day at 6:30 pm, except Sundays.

#### **DEVOTIONS**

This week are the first Wednesday, Thursday and Friday and Saturday of the month. The first Thursday - we pray for a vocation to priesthood and religious life; the first Friday - occasion to go to confession and the first Saturday of the month - a day dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. On the first Friday of the month the confession will be available from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 pm. in the parish hall.

## SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

We encourage you to take advantage of the reception of Jesus in Holy Communion at a time when we cannot attend the Holy Mass

<u>Holy Communion is available every Sunday from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. in the church.</u>

#### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

The Children, who complete the two-week preparation course for First Holy Communion in July in Polish, can receive their First Communion immediately no matter what day. If the parents choose the Sunday Mass, only one child may receive First Holy Communion during this Mass. Parents can choose whatever date for their child to receive Holy Communion. Due to sanitary restrictions, it is impossible for all children to receive their First Holy Communion at the same time.

# **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

Despite the closed churches for public Masses, we are with you and we feel your presence in the church. During this time of great trial of our faith, we invite you every day to our church for the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament to pray for the end of the pandemic, from 3pm to 6pm from Monday to Saturday. We must remember that only 10 people can be in the church. If we see that there are 10 people, we have to wait or come later.
