THANKSGIVING DAY

Thanksgiving is a harvest festival, a celebration of the Creator's love, who gives abundance of crops, sustains life, and gives food to the body. This day is celebrated annually mainly in the United States (fourth Thursday in November) and in Canada (second Monday in October). The history of this very special day and celebration in the United States dates back to the 17th century, 1621, when it was held for the first time at Plymouth Plantation in Massachusetts, according to tradition. Historical sources also indicate that similar ceremonies were held earlier in Canada in 1578.

This year it is worth asking what I am most grateful to God for. It was a year where, like never before, we experienced a pandemic, fear, the paralysis of our religious practices, the death of many loved ones. We must thank God for the presence of Christ in this difficult time of the pandemic and for the good that God's providence will derive from these experiences. Let us be grateful to God for everything we have and for each day of our lives!

NOVEMBER

The month of November is a time of prayer for all the deceased. In our memory, we recall those who have gone to the Father's house: parents, siblings, relatives, friends, priests, neighbors and all those whom we did meet in our lives and we owe them a debt of gratitude. We pray for them and commanding them to God's Mercy. In addition to our private prayers and ordered Holy Masses, there has been a tradition of Wypominki in the Church since 993. Saint John Paul II taught, "Prayer for the dead is an important duty, because even if they have passed away in grace and friendship with God, perhaps they still need the last cleansing to get the joy of heaven." One of the forms of prayerful care for the dead are Wypominki. The envelopes for Wypominki are located in the entrance to the church. We write the names of our deceased love ones on the top of an envelope and put them in a special treasury at the main altar. For the deceased mentioned in the envelopes, 30 Holy Masses are celebrated in November at the Provincial House of Missionary Oblates.
