MEMORIAL OF ST. LUKE, EVANGELIST

Tomorrow is the memory of St. Luke, Evangelist, who was a doctor before he began walking the Lord's way. On this day, let us remember about health professionals, about those who serve and care for us.

MEMORIAL OF ST. JOHN PAUL II

The Catholic Church around the world, on October 22, mentions St. John Paul II. The first Pole in history, who died on April 2, 2005, is one of the most rapidly elevated believers in modern times. He was proclaimed Blessed on May 1, 2011 by the present Senior Pope Benedict XVI, and on April 27, 2014, the first Bishop of Rome from Argentina and Latin America - Pope Francis, canonized him. During the beatification, the immediate successor of Pope Wojtyla, who already allowed the commencement of his beatification process a month and a half after the death of his predecessor, announced that the new

blessed would receive public worship on October 22, i.e. on the commemoration of the beginning of his pontificate.

NOVEMBER

The month of November is a time of prayer for all the deceased. In our memory, we recall those who have gone to the Father's house: parents, siblings, relatives, friends, priests, neighbors and all those whom we did meet in our lives and we owe them a debt of gratitude. We pray for them and commanding them to God's Mercy. In addition to our private prayers and ordered Holy Masses, there has been a tradition of Wypominki in the Church since 993. Saint John Paul II taught, "Prayer for the dead is an important duty, because even if they have passed away in grace and friendship with God, perhaps they still need the last cleansing to get the joy of heaven." One of the forms of prayerful care for the dead are Wypominki. The envelopes for Wypominki are located in the entrance to the church. We write the names of our deceased love ones on the top of an envelope and put them in a special treasury at the main altar. For the deceased mentioned in the envelopes, 30 Holy Masses are celebrated in November at the Provincial House of Missionary Oblates.
