This Sunday begins the Mission Week in which we will surround with prayer and material support, especially those who proclaim Christ in all continents of the world. OCTOBER – THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

October ends - the month of the rosary. We invite you every day at 6:30 pm for the rosary service (Sundays at 7:30 am). It is worth asking yourself the following questions: Have I prayed the rosary for the intentions of my relatives at least once this month? Did I manage to get my family together and invite them to pray together?

NOVEMBER

Next weekend is the time when we will visit the graves of our loved ones. The month of November is a time of prayer for all the deceased. In our memory, we recall those who have gone to the Father's house: parents, siblings, relatives, friends, priests, neighbors and all those whom we did meet in our lives and we owe them a debt of gratitude. We pray for them and commanding them to God's Mercy. The envelopes for *"All souls"* are located in the entrance to the church. We write the names of our deceased love ones on the top of an envelope and put them in a special treasury at the main altar. For the deceased mentioned in the envelopes, 30 Holy Masses are celebrated in November at the Provincial House of Missionary Oblates.

PLENARY INDUGENCE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Nov 1 - Nov 8 the faithful can receive a plenary indulgence given that they: visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased (Our Father, Glory Be), pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, go to confession and receive Communion and be free of attachment to sin. The indulgence can only be offered for the deceased. The faithful can receive a partial indulgence until the end of November.

SHARE LIFE

We have all felt the pain of disconnection: family members we could not travel to visit, friends we had not seen in over a year, the simple longing for a hug. For many in the Deaf community, the connections severed by the pandemic were even more profound. Many became isolated from their peers and could no longer access the programs they relied upon. Silent Voice is working to restore those connections. This ShareLife-funded agency is the only one in the area providing virtual programming for Deaf children, among its many services in American Sign Language. The number of people turning to ShareLife agencies like Silent Voice for support continues to grow. Each dollar you give will help build the connections we need to get through this pandemic together.
