CARDINAL COLLIN'S ANNOUCMENT

On September 24, Cardinal Collins announced that all bishops, priests, deacons, and all employees of the parish and Archdiocese of Toronto, as well as lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, and catechists must be vaccinated by October 8 and submit a vaccination certificate to the parish office. Therefore, we kindly ask all Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and catechists to provide the parish office with a copy of the vaccination certificate by September 8, at the latest. Cardinal Collins also asked all the faithful to be vaccinated for the common good, he writes: I very strongly urge every Catholic to become fully vaccinated, though we will make every effort to ensure places of worship remain open and accessible to all, regardless of vaccination status. The church should serve as a respite, a sanctuary of peace, prayer and welcome. We are heartened to see that the provincial government has not required proof of vaccination to enter a place of worship.
