NOVEMBER

This weekend is the time when we will visit the graves of our loved ones. The month of November is a time of prayer for all the deceased. In our memory, we recall those who have gone to the Father's house: parents, siblings, relatives, friends, priests, neighbors and all those whom we did meet in our lives and we owe them a debt of gratitude. We pray for them and commanding them to God's Mercy. The envelopes for "All souls" are located in the entrance to the church. We write the names of our deceased love ones on the top of an envelope and put them in a special treasury at the main altar. For the deceased mentioned in the envelopes, 30 Holy Masses are celebrated in November at the Provincial House of Missionary Oblates.

ALL SAINT' DAY

Tomorrow's feat of All Saints will be very joyful, because we will remember those who lived before us and who, after fulfilling God's will, achieved the eternal happiness of being with God in heaven. The Masses on All Saints' Day will be held at 8:00 am, 11:00 am and 7:00 pm. The rosary for the deceased mentioned in the All Souls envelopes will be prayed from November 1 to 9 at 6:30 pm.

ALL SOULS' DAY

On Tuesday, November 2 - All Souls' Day. In the liturgy, the Church commemorates all the faithful deceased who have preceded us on the path of faith.

PLENARY INDUGENCE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Nov 1 – Nov 8 the faithful can receive a plenary indulgence given that they: visit a cemetery and pray for the deceased (Our Father, Glory Be), pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, go to confession and receive Communion and be free of attachment to sin. The indulgence can only be offered for the deceased. The faithful can receive a partial indulgence until the end of November.
