PASTOR'S REFLECTION

God guides us along the paths of truth and love. He gave us commandments, i.e. clear rules, specific requirements. In a world polluted with hypocrisy, those who expose it, are exposed to various attacks and difficulties. However, we are looking at the Lord Jesus, who was not afraid to expose Pharisaical, untrue and dishonest attitudes, so let us have the courage always stand on the side of truth and honesty. God supports those who are faithful to Him.

PLENARY INDUGENCE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Apostolic Penitentiary - the highest tribunal in matters of conscience - published a decree in which, due to the ongoing pandemic, it extended plenary indulgences for the dead for the entire month of November. Indulgence is God's remission of temporal punishment for sins already forgiven as to guilt. Each baptized person can gain these indulgences after fulfilling the appropriate conditions for himself, or by offering them for the dead. Conditions for obtaining a plenary indulgence: no attachment to sin, even venial one. The state of sanctifying grace or sacramental confession, receiving Holy Communion, praying (eg "Our Father" and "Hail Mary") for the intentions of the Holy Father.

DEVOTION TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

November 13th, at our parish, we will continue our devotion of Fatima. The service will begin at 6 p.m. with the Rosary followed by the Holy Mass. We invite you to pray!

INDEPENDENCE DAY

On Thursday, November 11, we will celebrate the National Independence Day - the 103rd anniversary of Poland regaining independence. To thank God for regained freedom and independence and to ask for its good use, we invite you to a Mass, next Sunday at 11:00 am.
