PASTOR'S REFLECTION

WEEK OF PRAYERS FOR CHRISTIANS UNITY

From January 18 to 25, the Church is celebrating the Week of Universal Prayer for Christian Unity. During this time, Christians of various denominations gather for common services, conferences and ecumenical meetings. In this way, they make an effort to overcome all divisions and bring about the unity of the community of believers in Christ.

GRANDMA'S & GRANDPA'S DAY

On Friday, January 21, we will celebrate Grandma's Day, and on Saturday, January 22, we will celebrate Grandpa's Day. Let this be a time of special memory and kindness for our grandparents and grandmothers. For the living, let us ask for God's abundance of blessing, and for the dead, the joy of eternal life.

LIMIT IN THE CHURCHES IN ONTARIO

Churches in the province of Ontario have a limit of 50% of the church capacity, which does not change the current rules in our parish. In church, we have our mouth and nose covered with a mask. If the church is full, we go to the parish hall to participate in the Holy Mass. Please also keep your distance and disinfect your hands when entering the church. We would also like to remind you that we go to Holy Communion in procession; we all leave the pews so as not to rub against each other. Holy Communion we only accept on hand.

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD & THE PURIFICATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On February 2, the Catholic Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In Poland, the feast emphasizes Virgin Mary, as on that day Mary was purified according to the religious law, followed by Jesus' presentation in the temple. On Wednesday, we will come to the church with our candles to bless them so that they remind us of the Light of the World, Jesus Christ for the entire year, especially during difficulties. This feast also ends the traditional period of Christmas Carol singing. The candles can be purchased at the parish office.

RELIGION CLASSES

Due to the introduction of new Covid-19 restrictions by the Ontario government, religion classes have been canceled in January. Regular classes will start on February 5, 2022. Children who prepare for the First Communion and Confirmation will receive materials from their catechists for January to work at home. In the New Year of 2022, we wish God's care, health and peace of heart.

PAINTING OF THE CHURCH

We thank all those who made donations for painting the church. As a reminder, the painting contract is \$ 90,000. In the last week, \$ 2,000 has been collected, a total of \$ 88,150. The envelopes for painting the church are at the entrance to the church. The parishioners who put offerings for the painting of the church are eligible to receive a tax receipt.

MEETING OF SENIORS

The regular meetings of seniors can begin from the New Year. However, due to the close contacts of seniors during the meetings, the weaker immunity of their organisms, only fully vaccinated seniors can participate in the meetings.

SUNDAY OFFERING ENVELOPES FOR 2022

Donation Envelopes for 2022 may be picked up in the parish hall. The parishioners, who until now have numbers above number **500**, have received the new numbers. We ask kindly to write down on the envelope your offering in the \$ place and not to use the envelopes from the previous years. Parishioners using envelopes for their donations are eligible to receive a tax receipt at the end of the year. The tax receipt will be sent at the beginning February 2022.
