SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today is the sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time in the liturgical year. Every Holy Mass is an adoration of God and the sanctification of man. Let the word of God heard and participation in sacred rituals be a help for us in living our everyday life as a Christian.

DEVOTION TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Today, we will continue our devotion of Fatima. The service will begin at 6 p.m. with the Rosary followed by the Holy Mass at 7 p.m.

MULTIPLE INTENSIONS MASSES

Next Multiple Intentions Mass will be celebrated on Wednesday, February 16 at 7pm. Intentions can be booked in the parish office only.

LENT

Lent this year will begin on Wednesday, March 2. On this day, there will be no devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Multiple Intentions Mass. On Ash Wednesday, before each Mass, there will be an opportunity for confession in the parish hall.

THE FEAST OF ST. CASIMIR

The parish feast of St. Casimir's will be held on Friday, March 4. We invite you to a special Mass at 11:00 am with the participation

of many priests, chaired by the Provincial of Missionary Oblates, Alfred Grzempa. The faithful, who will attend a Holy Mass in the church, can obtain a plenary indulgence under ordinary conditions, i.e. the state of sanctifying grace, receiving Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions given by the Holy Father.

THE ADOPTION OF THE CONCEIVED CHILD

The adoption of a conceived child will take place on Friday, March 25, during the evening Mass.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Currently, confession takes place every Friday and Saturday from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the parish hall.

LIMIT IN THE CHURCHES IN ONTARIO

Churches in the province of Ontario have a limit of 50% of the church capacity, which does not change the current rules in our parish. In church, we have our mouth and nose covered with a mask. If the church is full, we go to the parish hall to participate in the Holy Mass. Please also keep your distance and disinfect your hands when entering the church. We would also like to remind you that we go to Holy Communion in procession; we all leave the pews so as not to rub against each other. Holy Communions we only accept on hand.

THE LORD'S DAY

Saturday Mass instead of Sunday's Mass. In the first centuries of the Church, the Sunday Eucharist was celebrated as early as Saturday evening, in keeping with the Jewish timekeeping tradition, according to which the next day would begin at dusk. During the persecution of the Church, Christians gathered frequently during the Saturday night to celebrate the resurrection of Christ that happened at night. The Second Vatican Council returned to the tradition of the early Church and allowed the celebration of Sunday Mass on Saturday evening and even in the afternoon, but the Mass may not be celebrated earlier than 4pm.

When is it not a sin to miss a Sunday Mass? It is not a sin to miss a Mass if there is a valid reason to do so, such as illness, the need to care for a bedridden person, or an infant when reaching church is impossible. It is impossible to discuss all cases, in case of doubt, ask your confessor. However, we must remember that being on vacation does not release us from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass.
