THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

This Wednesday, we begin the holy and salutary time of Lent. The external sign of our entering the path of penance and conversion will be to sprinkle ashes on our heads and to take up various forms of mortification. Ashes reminds us that everything earthly came into being from the dust of the earth and will turn to dust again. Lent is a time of penance, fasting, sacrifice, and prayer, and it is a time to serve our conversion, to prepare our hearts for a fruitful experience of the joyful feasts of the Lord's Resurrection. The church commandment obliges us during Lenten penance to refrain from participating in parties, to go to confession and receive the Holy Communion on Easter. We encourage everyone to make an interior commitment to self-denial for Christ. It is not too late. What will you give up for Lent for Christ? Maybe smoking, drinking alcohol, wasting time on the Internet, or maybe you decide to be better, kinder to your wife, husband or in-laws. Alternatively, maybe you will give up sweets, gossiping, abusing TV, etc. Choose at least one thing to let you know that you are experiencing Lent. Do it for crucified Christ.

MARCH 1 – MEMORY DAY OF THE BUNISHED SOLDIERS

On Tuesday, March 1, is the National Day of Remembrance of "Cursed Soldiers". Since 2011, it has the status of a public holiday. In our prayers, let us remember all those who, in the difficult times of the communist regime, took up the fight for freedom and sovereignty of our homeland. May memory and prayer accompany this day for the heroes of our Homeland. Holy Mass at. 19.00 will be celebrated for the intention of the murdered, fallen and deceased Unbreakable Soldiers.

LENT

Let this year will begin on Wednesday, March 2. On this day, there will be no devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Multiple Intensions Mass. The Masses will be celebrated at 8am, 10:30 am and 7pm. <u>On Ash Wednesday, before each Mass, there will be an opportunity for confession in the parish hall.</u>

On Ash Wednesday, Catholics are obliged to fast (at most eating one full meal and two light meals) and abstain from meat.

We invite everyone to our traditional Polish Lenten devotions: the **Lenten Lamentations** will be held every Sunday at 6:15 p.m. and the **Way of the Cross** every Friday at 6:15 p.m. in Polish. Christians, who devoutly participate in the Way of the Cross, are granted a plenary indulgence.

THE FEAST OF ST. CASIMIR

The parish feast of St. Casimir's, the patron of our parish, will be held on Friday, March 4. We invite you to a special Mass at 11:00 am with the participation of many priests, chaired by the Provincial of Missionary Oblates, Alfred Grzempa. The faithful, who will attend a Holy Mass in the church, can obtain a plenary indulgence under ordinary conditions, i.e. the state of sanctifying grace, receiving Holy Communion and prayer for the intentions given by the Holy Father.

ELIMINATION OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

Last week, the Ontario Prime Minister announced that most provincial Covid-19 restrictions will be eliminated in two phases in the coming weeks. The first phase of the easing of restrictions began last Thursday, and the second phase will start on Tuesday, March 1. This means that parish groups can already use the parish hall for meetings, however masks are obligatory for all meeting participants. The limit of participants now is a maximum of 50. In church, we have our mouth and nose covered with a mask. If the church is full, we go to the parish hall to participate in the Holy Mass. Please also keep your distance and disinfect your hands when entering the church. We would also like to remind you that we go to Holy Communion in procession; we all leave the pews so as not to rub against each other. Holy Communions we only accept on hand.
