WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

February 11, the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, the Church celebrates the annual World Day of the Sick, which was established by Pope John Paul II, May 13, 1992, on the 11th anniversary of the assassination attempt on his life, and at the same

time on the 75th anniversary of the Fatima apparitions. This day is always celebrated on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, famous for many healings. That day we embrace our sick with the prayers.

DEVOTION TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

February 13, at our parish, we will continue our devotion of Fatima. The service will begin at 6 p.m. with the Rosary followed by the Holy Mass at 7 p.m.

LIMIT IN THE CHURCHES IN ONTARIO

Churches in the province of Ontario have a limit of 50% of the church capacity, which does not change the current rules in our parish. In church, we have our mouth and nose covered with a mask. If the church is full, we go to the parish hall to participate in the Holy Mass. Please also keep your distance and disinfect your hands when entering the church. We would also like to remind you that we go to Holy Communion in procession; we all leave the pews so as not to rub against each other. Holy Communion we only accept on hand.

THE LORD'S DAY

Many parishioners ask us whether it is a grave sin to miss Holy Mass on Sunday without good reason. Can I choose Saturday Mass instead of Sunday Mass? Can fears of contracting covid in the church be a reason for being released from the obligation of Sunday Mass? We will try to answer these questions in the upcoming bulletins. The obligation to keep the Lord's Day holy results from the third commandment of the Decalogue, reminding, "Remember that you should keep holy day" and the first church commandment "On Sundays and holidays, you must attend Holy Mass and refrain from unnecessary work". The Code of Canon Law, which regulates the rules of life of Catholics also in matters related to the use of the sacraments, states in canon 1247: "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Mass. Moreover, they are to abstain from those works and affairs, which hinder the worship to be rendered to God, the joy proper to the Lord's Day, or the suitable relaxation of mind and body". Participation in the Holy Mass on Sundays and public holidays it is therefore a Catholic's duty. Sunday Mass can be replaced with Saturday, the so-called evening: "A person who assists at a Mass celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the feast day itself or in the evening of the preceding day satisfies the obligation of participating in the Mass." (CIC can. 1248 §1). CDN...
