Let us pray today for all those working in missions that they will experience God's help and support from the community of believers.

THE ADOPTION OF THE CONCIVED CHILD

Spiritual adoption is a prayer for a conceived child. It lasts nine months and consists in the daily recitation of one rosary mystery for the intention of the child and the parents. Any additional resolutions can be attached to the prayer. Spiritual adoption came about after the apparitions in Fatima, being a response to Our Lady's call to pray the rosary, repentance and atone for the sins that hurt her Immaculate Heart the most. On Friday, March 25, during the Mass at 7pm, we will start this year's spiritual adoption of a conceived child. Please join us.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Confession takes place from Wednesday to Saturday from 6:30 pm in the confessionals in the church.

ELIMINATION OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

As of March 1, further covid restrictions were lifted. We are returning to an almost normal life from 2 years ago. Therefore, there is no space or social distance in the church, so we sit wherever we want. There is no limit to the number of believers in the church. Parish groups can meet as before. Teachers, ministers and catechists no longer need to test for the virus. Confession takes place in the confessional from Wednesday to Saturday at 6:30pm and on Sunday 1/2 hour before the Mass. Holy water is already at the entrance to the church in stoups. We can take Holy Communion by mouth, but the faithful are encouraged to continue receiving Holy Communion on hand, or into tiny containers, i.e. a ciborium, or on a tiny corporal. However, masks are obligatory in the church and at meetings. We have not given each other the sign of peace yet. We encourage you to use antibacterial gels, i.e. sanitizers.

OUR YOUTH ACTIONS

During Lent, our youth is organizing a food collection for the poor, which will take place on Sunday, March 27. Food can be put into boxes in the parish hall. Please bring only tinned food, cans, rice,

pasta, coffee, jars, so food that does not spoil so quickly. Please bring food with a valid use-by date.

Sunday, April 3, our youth will sell dumplings. We ask you to buy dumplings from young people and support their activities in this way. Let us be glad that we have young people in our faith community, but let us also support them.
