#### FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Today is the fourth Sunday of Lent, known as "Laetare", or Lenten Sunday of Joy. Its name derives from the first words of the entry antiphon in Latin: "Laetare, Jerusalem", meaning "Rejoice, Jerusalem".

#### ELIMINATION OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

We are returning to an almost normal life from 2 years ago. Therefore, there is no space or social distance in the church, so we sit wherever we want. There is no limit to the number of believers in the church. The mask are not obligatory in the church anymore. Parish groups can meet as before. Teachers, ministers and catechists no longer need to test for the virus. Confession takes place in the confessional from Wednesday to Saturday at 6:30pm and on Sunday 1/2 hour before the Mass. Holy water is already at the entrance to the church in stoups. We can take Holy Communion by mouth, but the faithful are encouraged to continue receiving Holy Communion on hand, or into tiny containers, i.e. a ciborium, or on a tiny corporal. We have not given each other the sign of peace yet. We encourage you to use antibacterial gels, i.e. sanitizers.
