PILGRIMAGE TO MIDLAND

We ask all parish organizations with banners to be ready for the procession at 11:15 a.m. **PROGRAM:** 9:00 a.m. - Confession; 10:30 a.m. - Rosary; 11:15 a.m. - Entry of the Walking Pilgrimage; 11:30 a.m. - Holy Mass; 1:00 p.m. - Devotion of blessing the herbs and flowers. The bus ticket costs \$50 and can be purchased at the parish office.

WALKING PILGRIMAGE TO MIDLAND

Annual Walking Pilgrimage to Martyrs' Shrine in Midland will take place from August 8 to 14. This year's theme: "Get up! I appoint you as a witness of what you have seen." (Acts 26:16). The cost of participation is \$150 for the entire week per person, or \$30 for one day and covers, among others: accommodation, luggage transport, toilet and truck rentals. We provide a warm dinner at each campsite. On-line registration only: www.pielgrzymka.ca Pilgrims should take with them: intention, rosary, OHIP card, tent, sleeping bag, mattress or sleeping mat, soup bowl and utensils, packed lunch, water bottle, cotton socks, T-shirts with sleeves, toiletries, first aid kit, sunscreen, bug repellent, comfortable (not new!) footwear, headgear and raincoat.



Who can participate in the pilgrimage? Anyone who has the strength and perseverance can participate in the pilgrimage. However, we do not encourage elders, those who are sick, those with weak hearts or with very small children to participate. Youth up to 19 years of age may participate in the pilgrimage only after receiving writing permission from their parents or guardians. **What is there to do during the pilgrimage?** Each day is filled with praying the rosary, conferences, testimonies of the leaders as well as the participants' of the pilgrimage, singing, and conversation. Attendance at morning Mass is mandatory. In the evening, there is time for a bonfire, singing and fun, and sometimes even a soccer game.

The OEN can be found in your child's report card. Please note that if your child is currently in grade 8, they cannot attend classes in 2022 - 2023. We encourage parents to register their children to the classes at the Polish School at our parish.
