SENIORS' MEETINGS BY ZOOM

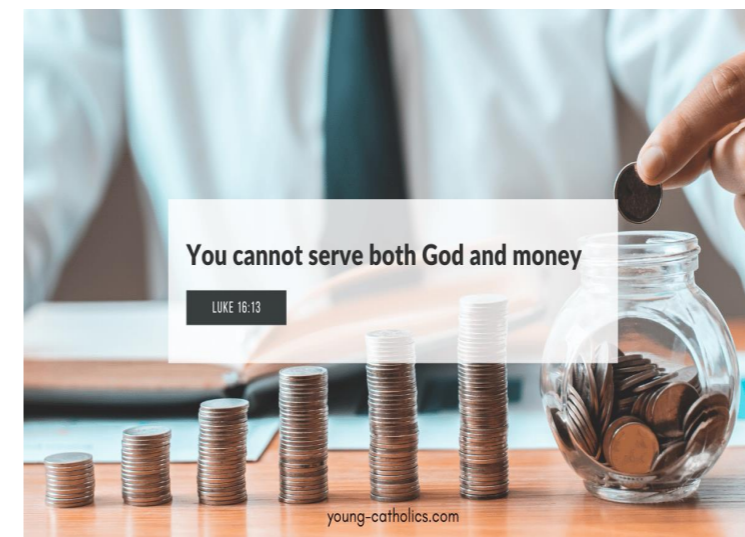
