MARION DAY RETREAT FOR WOMEN

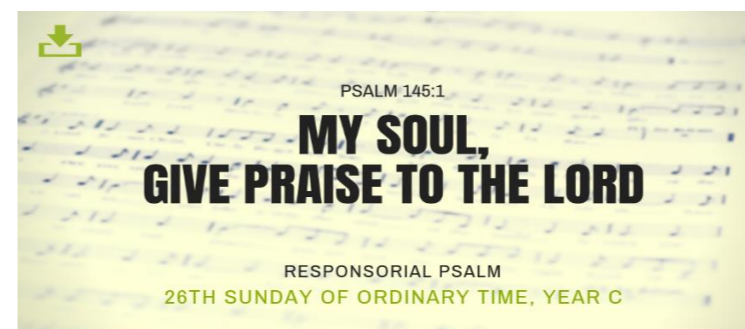
