# FEAST OF THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On Thursday, September 8, we celebrate the feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Scriptures nowhere mention the birth of Mary. Tradition, however, tells that her parents were St. Anna and St. Joachim. They were pious Jews. Despite their old age, they did not have a child. In those days, it was considered a punishment for the sins of ancestors. That is why Anna and Joachim earnestly asked God for a child. God listened to their prayers and, as a reward for the unlimited trust placed in him, God made Anna give birth to a daughter, Mary. We do not know where Mary was born or when she came to earth. According to all the information available to us, Mary was born between 20 and 16 years before the birth of Jesus.
