PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Concern for eternal life plays a secondary role in the lives of many modern people, and is sometimes considered something embarrassing. Many people also try to use earthly standards to judge supernatural reality. In addition, this reality turns out to be so different from our imaginations. Our search for eternal life expresses the courage of a faith that takes seriously encouragement to discover God as complete happiness. This is illustrated by the history of the persecution of the Maccabees. The determination and courage of the tormented brothers and the certainty that they are in the hands of the Creator give them great strength to endure the greatest torments. They take a dignified attitude towards their torturers.

SHEPHERDS' TRUST

The Shepherds' Trust supports the needs of the retired diocesan clergy of the Archdiocese of Toronto who have served our family of faith, bringing us the sacraments and

enriching our parishes, homes, schools, hospitals and countless other gatherings through their ministry. The Trust was started by lay people who recognized the needs of our retired priests and helped to establish the Trust as a reflection of the gratitude and appreciation of the faithful parishioners in the Archdiocese of Toronto. Through your support of The Shepherds' Trust, our retired priests are given the dignity of adequate monthly allowance, health care and other assistance in their golden years often well beyond the recognized retirement age of 75. Parishioners of the Archdiocese have always responded with great generosity to the annual Shepherds' Trust fundraising campaign. As a result, the Trust is in a good long-term financial position. It continues to provide a modest income and health benefit to our retired clergy. The weekend of November 12/13, 2022 is the annual special collection for The Shepherds' Trust. Over the years, the laity have generously offered their time, talent and treasure to support our retired priests. We thank you for everything you have done for our retired priests over the years.

THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Wednesday, November 9, is the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. The Lateran Basilica is the cathedral church of the Bishop

of Rome, i.e. the Pope. Above the entrance, there is an inscription in Latin "Mother and Head of all the churches of the City and the World". Until the fourteenth century, it was the center of the Church's life. This holiday is also an expression of our unity with the successor of Saint Peter - Pope Francis.

REMEMBRANCE OF ALL SOULS

The month of November is a time of prayer for all the dead. In our memory, we recall those who have gone to the Father's house: parents, siblings, relatives, friends, priests and all those whom we have met in our lives and we owe them a debt of gratitude. We do this to pray for them, commanding them to God's Mercy. In addition to our private prayers and ordered Holy Masses, there has been All Souls Remembrance (Wypominki) tradition in the Church since 993. The envelopes for All Souls Remembrance are located in the entrance to the church, and we put them in a special treasury at the main altar. For the deceased mentioned in the All Souls envelopes, 30 Masses are celebrated in November, at the Provincial House of Missionary Oblates.

PLENARY INDULGENCE

From November 1 to November 8, you can get a plenary indulgence and offer it for the dead. The conditions for the indulgence include visiting the cemetery and praying for the dead. Moreover: lack of attachment to sin, the state of sanctifying grace, receiving Holy Communion, praying for the intentions appointed by the Holy Father.

INDEPENDENCE DAY

This Friday, November 11, is Independence Day in Poland. We invite you to pray together for our homeland. Our prayerful memory will embrace all those who died in the fight for her freedom. Let the national flag be the external sign of our celebration.

A DAY OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

This Sunday, November 13, is the Day of Solidarity with the Persecuted Church, celebrated since 2009 (always on the second Sunday of November). Also on this day we will celebrate the fifth World Day of the Poor established by Pope Francis.
