OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE ROSARY

We invite everyone: children, youth and adults to participate in the rosary service every day at 6:30 pm, and on Sunday at 7:30 am. Those who cannot come to the church for prayer are invited to pray the rosary at home. We also remind you that on Sundays and Wednesdays we recite the glorious mysteries, on Mondays and Saturdays - joyful mysteries, on Tuesdays and Fridays - painful mysteries, and on Thursdays - mysteries of light. People who pray the rosary can gain the grace of a plenary indulgence, the forgiveness of purgatory punishment for sins. Under ordinary conditions, such an indulgence can be obtained by praying one part of the rosary.

27. SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today is the twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time. The Sunday liturgy replaced the liturgical commemoration of the Holy Guardian Angels. May we be accompanied by faith in the presence and help of the Holy Angels whom God has called to guard us on the paths of our lives.
