OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE ROSARY

We invite everyone: children, youth and adults to participate in the rosary service every day at 6:30 pm, and on Sunday at 7:30 am. Those who cannot come to the church for prayer are invited to pray the rosary at home. We also remind you that on Sundays and Wednesdays we recite the glorious mysteries, on Mondays and Saturdays - joyful mysteries, on Tuesdays and Fridays - painful mysteries, and on Thursdays - mysteries of light. People who pray the rosary can gain the grace of a plenary indulgence, the forgiveness of purgatory punishment for sins. Under ordinary conditions, such an indulgence can be obtained by praying one part of the rosary.

28th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today is the twenty-eighth Sunday of the church year. In the community of God's people, we pray that the good God will move us through his grace to perform good works. May participation in the Eucharist help us in fulfilling this task. Let us open ourselves to the word of God so that it may help us seek and find God in all things.
