THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On Saturday, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This celebration, celebrated annually on March 25, reminds us of the great event that marked the beginning of a new era in the history of humankind. Archangel Gabriel came to Mary, a woman from Nazareth, to announce to her that the promises of the prophets would be fulfilled in her, and that her Son, whom she would conceive in a miraculous and virginal way through the Holy Spirit, would be the Son of God himself. The fact that this solemnity often falls during Lent makes us realize that the mystery of the Incarnation is inseparable from the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION OF A CONCEIVED CHILD

Spiritual Adoption of a Child Conceived at Risk of Extermination is a nine-month prayer for one child chosen by God, who develops in the mother's womb, but who is at risk of abortion. The daily prayer of Spiritual Adoption begins on March 25 on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord and lasts until Christmas. In our parish, Spiritual Adoption will start this Saturday during the Holy Mass. at. 8:00 am.
