FEAST OF ST. CASIMIR

Today we celebrate the parish indulgence of St. Casimir. Those who will attend the Mass in the church and will be in a state of sanctifying grace, they will receive Holy Communion and pray for the intentions given by the Holy Father; they will gain a plenary indulgence. After the Eucharist, there will also be an opportunity to venerate the relics of St. Casimir.

St. Casimir was the son of the Polish king Casimir Jagiellonczyk. He was born in Krakow in 1458. He was distinguished by a special purity of spirit and mercy towards the poor. He took an active part in political life alongside his father. A zealous worshiper of the Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary, he devoted much time to prayer. After a long-term lung disease, he died in Grodno on March 4, 1484. He was buried in Vilnius and his relics are kept in the cathedral there.

CANDIDATES FOR CONFIRMATION

The Seven Last Words (Sayings) of Jesus on the Cross-are a collection of seven short sentences spoken by Jesus

during his crucifixion just before his death. They are found in the four Gospels.
