DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

The Church celebrates the Feast of Divine Mercy on the first Sunday after Easter. Pope John Paul II established it for the entire Church on the day of the canonization of Sr. Faustyna Kowalska on April 30, 2000. Currently, this feast is also called Divine Mercy Sunday. Earlier, Cardinal Franciszek Macharski was the first to enter it into the liturgical calendar for the Archdiocese of Krakow in 1985, and then some Polish bishops in their dioceses. At the request of the Polish Episcopate, St. John Paul II in 1995 introduced this holiday for all dioceses in Poland. Jesus spoke for the first time about the establishment of this feast in Plock in 1931, when he communicated his will regarding the creation of the image to St. Faustina: I want it to be a feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter - this Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy (Diary 49). The choice of the first Sunday after Easter for the Feast of Mercy has a deep theological meaning, which indicates a close relationship between the Easter mystery of the Redemption and the mystery of God's mercy. The holiday is not only a day of special adoration of God in the mystery of mercy, but also a time of grace for all people.

On Good Friday, our youth prepared a Passion of the Way of the Cross, combined with re-enacting scenes of subsequent stations. A very large group of believers gathered in the church, who wanted to spend the evening reflecting on the passion and death of the Lord Jesus. An important role was played by our youth, who not only prepared the whole thing, but also played the Stations of the Cross in a beautiful way. We thank Father Zbyszek for preparing the whole thing. An incredibly important role was played by musicians who played their instruments live between stations, in addition to music written by themselves. God bless!

This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world.
