#### PALM SUNDAY

Today, Palm Sunday, we begin Holy Week in the Catholic Church, during which we will experience the most sublime salvific events: the institution of the sacraments of the Eucharist and Priesthood, then we will experience the Passion of the Lord, and finally we will resound with a joyful "Hallelujah" announcing the Resurrection of Christ.

On Palm Sunday, the Church celebrates Christ's messianic entry into Jerusalem to accomplish his paschal mystery. Therefore, at the beginning of each Holy Mass, palms are blessed. <u>Today</u>, we will have last Easter Lamentation Service at 6:15 pm.

## WAY OF THE CROSS

On Good Friday, we invite you to the Stations of the Cross prepared by young people from the St. Casimir's Parish at 8:15 pm. Our youth will perform the Stations of the Cross with music prepared by them.

#### EASTER CONFESSION

Easter confession will take place in our parish today, from 3 pm to 5 pm in the lower and upper parish halls. During this time, the exhibition of the Blessed Sacrament and private adoration will take place in the church. We encourage you to take advantage of the sacrament of reconciliation during this time, because it will be the last opportunity in our parish. During the Holy Week, our fathers will hear confessions in other Polish parishes in the evenings.

### MASSES IN THE HOLY WEEK

On Holy Monday, Holy Tuesday and Holy Wednesday - Masses will only be held at 8:00 am. In the evening, fathers will help in the sacrament of reconciliation in other Polish parishes. Intentions for the Multiple Intensions Mass on Wednesday, April 5, have been moved to Wednesday, April 19.

## **HOLY THURSDAY**

HOLY THURSDAY - The Mass of the Lord's Supper is the gate of the Paschal Triduum, which must be crossed in order to understand the meaning of the passion, death and resurrection of Christ. It has a very solemn character - all the priests serving in the

parish perform it. Before the Liturgy of the Word, the hymn Glory to God is solemnly sung, which we have not sung for the forty days of Lent. The performance of this song of praise to God is very significant and takes place with the participation of the organ. Today we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and the Sacrament of the Priesthood. The solemn liturgy in our temple will begin at 7 pm. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament after the liturgy will last until midnight.

## GOOD FRIDAY

Good Friday is the only day of the year when no Masses celebrated in churches. On Good Friday, the Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is celebrated, which consists of the reading of the Holy Scriptures, the adoration of the Cross and the distribution of Holy Communion. In our church, the liturgies of Lent will take place at 3pm and 7pm in Polish and at 5pm in English. Adoration at the Lord's Tomb will last until midnight. On Good Friday, the novena to the Divine Mercy begins. We pray it privately.

On Good Friday, believers are obliged to fast, quantitatively and qualitatively, that is abstaining from meat foods and eating only three meals a day, including once to fill; on this day, it is not appropriate to consume alcohol.

## HOLY SATURDAY

HOLY SATURDAY is the day when the Church remains at the tomb of the Savior, in silence and concentration, considering what happened on Good Friday, the saving passion and death of Christ. From the first centuries, Christians abstained on this day, as on Good Friday, from celebrating the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. They did not even gather for community prayer, so as not to disturb the silence and reverie of that day. Instead, they tried to find time to consider the immensity of Christ's love, which for the salvation of man did not stop even before death.

Blessing of food baskets will take place in the parish hall from 11 am and will last until 4pm. The liturgy of the Easter Vigil on Saturday in Polish and English will start at 7pm.

## RESURRECTION

The Holy Mass of Resurrection on Easter morning will take place at 6 am. The procession will take place inside the church.

## FLOWERS FOR THE LORD' TOMB

We are asking for flowers for the Lord's tomb, especially white hydrangeas.
