THE PASTOR’S REFLECTION

Today we are experiencing the celebration of God's Body. The celebration of Corpus Christi has its origin in the visions of St. Juliana of Liège and was first introduced in the diocese of Liège in France, but soon extended to the whole Church. A miracle that took place in Bolsena near Orvieto contributed to this: during a holy mass, which was celebrated by a priest who doubted the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, the host raised by him began to bleed, which convinced the unbelieving priest and many others - in the past and today. The fate of this celebration was different and various meanings were attributed to it: confession of faith in the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament; the sanctification of towns and villages; blessing of the fields, asking for good weather and harvest. Corpus Christi is a celebration of the Eucharist. Two thoughts have come to the fore in my experience recently. The first concerns fragility. When I break the host over the altar, I often think about this fragility and that this is how Jesus wants to come to us. “Take and eat, this is my body given for you.” For you and for you. You can do what you want with it. You can despise him, ignore him, and show indifference to him. You can accept it with love, take it inside you and watch it grow inside you and grow with it. The second thought, taken from John Paul II, concerns communion. I was delighted with the Pope's observation that in communion not only each of us receives Christ, but Christ also receives each of us! Christ comes to communion to receive me. This is really a great holiday for me!

RENOVATION OF THE CHURCH ROOF & AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM



The water channel on our roof needs immediate repair. The channel is part of the roof where water flows from the huge surface of the metal roof. The roof was installed in year 2000 and is in excellent condition, however the drainage channel, which is 29 meters long and one meter wide, is lined with thick rubber and this rubber is in critical condition. Full of holes and damaged from falling water from the roof and sun rays. The fact that the church is not leaking yet is truly a miracle, and the church was renovated two years ago. By decision

of the Financial Committee, we proceed to repair the roof as soon as possible. This project has been entrusted to Jerry's Roofing, and the cost of this massive work is \$50,000. Thank you all for your support and donations to the Renovation Fund. So far, we've raised \$8,080 for the roof repair. By decision of the Financial Committee, the list of golden donors was renewed, which is located in the corridor leading to the choir. Contributors who contribute \$1,000 to the renovation will be added to the original 1995 list of gold donors.

We would like to thank the following people who have been entered on the list of golden donors: Baran Stefania, Stachulak Anna, Semczyszyn Piotr.

Also the air conditioning in our church needs modernization and repair. The compressor responsible for cooling the back of the church has burnt out and needs to be replaced. This is a complicated and very expensive process. Also the air conditioning in the parish hall needs repair. A Polish company from Brampton is responsible for the repair. Air conditioning was established by the late Father Antoni Mendrela in 1995.

MONEY BOX FOR THE POOR

There was always a box for offerings to the poor at the back of the church. It was stolen three weeks ago. There were not many offerings inside the box, but the damage is significant. Currently, there is a metal box on the table on the left for offerings to the poor. For safety, it has been bolted to the table. Thank you to everyone who makes donations for those in need.
