#### THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

At the beginning of every Holy Mass, we ask God to forgive our weaknesses and sins. The Lord God generously forgives us because he sent his Son to erase the debt of our sins. This forgiveness of sins also obliges us to forgive others. This is our Christian calling. We are to realize this especially during the Eucharist.

The thought of forgiving others is present throughout today's liturgy of the word. It resonated particularly strongly in the Gospel. When Peter asks how many times he should forgive his brother when he sins against him, the Lord Jesus replies that it is seventy-seven times, that is, always. Then he graphically shows us this truth in the parable of the unmerciful servant. The words from the first reading also call us to forgiveness, because whoever does not forgive, whoever takes revenge, will face the Lord's vengeance. In addition, Saint In the second reading, Paul reminds us that we all belong to the Lord, because He died and rose for all. In life and death, we belong to Him. We are all indebted to God who loves everyone equally. We are to remember this in our relationships with others. We are to forgive each other, not hold grudges and thus overcome the evil that separates us from God and people.


