THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Today's parable does not have an economic meaning, but a religious one. This is not a recommendation on how to reward work. This parable does not talk about the principles of fair remuneration for work, but contrasts divine and human justice. It is a kind of commentary on the words spoken by the Lord in the Book of Isaiah: *My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways.* Why did workers who received a denarius for a day's work protest? Was their payment unfair? No - they received as much as was customary and in the contract, they concluded with the employer. They did not get too little - they protested because their co-workers, who worked shorter hours, got too much! So their sense of justice was laced with envy and jealousy. However, God's justice is "positive" justice, generous, giving abundantly, beyond ordinary measure, the justice of goodness, and not of envy like human justice.
