THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

We are not many days away from Christmas. The Advent weeks of joyful waiting pass quickly. The last few days bring the most emotions. We are familiar with these holidays. "Taming" took years. They have been a part of our lives since our early childhood. They have become such a part of our lives that it is difficult to imagine life without them. Advent is a special time of seeking and finding God's closeness. It is a time of getting used to God. It can also be said that man's Advent lasts almost from the beginning of his existence. Man has always sought God and known Him to the best of his abilities. He found God because God allowed himself to be found. All these preparations and ceremonies are only the setting for the greatest and unique event in the history of humankind; God became man. He became man so that we could come as close to Him as possible. Man has the opportunity to become so familiar with the closeness of God that while waiting for Him and meeting Him, we can learn the "price of happiness."

ADVENT RETREAT

Today we begin the Advent retreat. We warmly welcome the missionary from Ukraine, Father Krzysztof Machelski, OMI. Let us plan our time so that we can take part in retreat meetings. On these days we can also receive the sacrament of penance and reconciliation. However, let us not postpone confession until the last days of Advent. <u>On Tuesday, we especially invite the elderly and the sick to Holy Mas at 10:30, during which the faithful will receive the Sacrament of the Sick.</u> On Wednesday, at the end of the retreat, a collection will be collected for the needs of missionaries working in Ukraine. Envelopes are located at the back of the church.

RORATE MASSES

During Advent, we invite you to the Holy Masses called Rorate, on Wednesdays and Saturdays at 8:00 a.m. Rorate - Advent Mass celebrated in the morning, emphasize the uniqueness of this period. The name "rorate" comes from the entrance song, starting with the words "Rorate caeli" – "Drop the dew heavens". The Rorate Mass is a votive Mass for the Blessed Virgin Mary during Advent. This Mass is one of the signs of Mary's special presence during Advent, because she was waiting for the Messiah in a special way.

CHRISTMAS CONFESSION

Today, Christmas confession takes place from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the upper parish hall. During this time, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the church, where we can prepare for confession, adore Jesus or quietly say penance and pray. We invite you.


