Statistics about our community: There are 1,753 families registered in the parish register. Last year we had 22 baptisms, 7 weddings, 71 funerals, 14 children received First Holy Communion, 8 young people received the sacrament of confirmation, Fathers made about 300 pastoral visits to the sick. Our community is large, so let us take care of ourselves, respect each other and, above all, let us strive for the development of spiritual life in our families and the Polish community.

THE HEATING IN THE CHURCH

For the period from November 11 to December 10, we paid \$1,946.33 for heating the church, and we paid \$3,174.87 for the entire system, i.e. both parish halls, the Polish school premises, the office and the rectory.


