## RESURECTION OF JESUS CHRIST

On this joyful day of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, we came to our parish church to sing the joyful ALLELUJA, because today the whole of creation is singing this joyful ALLELUJA to the glory of the Lord. Like the women and the Apostles, we run to the tomb, which is empty, and try to understand what happened that night and that morning. Moreover, we want to shout: "Christ, my Lord and hope, is risen!"

In addition, from this empty tomb, we send our dear parishioners and guests our warmest wishes that the Risen Lord and Savior will illuminate every moment of life with His grace and blessing and grant health and all the necessary gifts.

## **EASTER MONDAY**

Tomorrow is Monday in the octave of Easter, Holy Masses will be held in Polish at 9:30 am, 11:00 am and 7:00 pm. For many parishioners, tomorrow is a day off from work; let us try to maintain the festive character of the entire Paschal octave in our homes and families - until next Sunday. Let us restore the Easter greeting in our families "CHRIST ROSE FROM THE DEAD! HE IS TRULY RISEN!"

#### EASTER OCTAVE

The solemn celebration of Easter extends into the octave. Each day of this week is a celebration, so there is no fasting or abstinence from meat food this Friday.

### **DEVOTIONS**

During the Paschal Octave, we will experience the Thursday before the first Friday, the first Friday and the first Saturday of the month. On these days, we invite you to the church to pray together: on Thursday for vocations to God's service, on Friday to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the spirit of reparation for our sins and the sins of the whole world, on Saturday for the reparative rosary. On Friday, adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be held from 3:00 p.m., and on Saturday, Service to Our Lady will start at 18:00.

We sincerely thank everyone who prepared our temple for Easter with their work. The Financial Committee analyzed the financial report for 2023 prepared by Mark Garczyński, our parish's accountant. Copies of the reports are available to all parishioners in the parish office. We would like to thank all parishioners who feel responsible for maintaining our parish and regularly make donations. The parish is maintained only from the donations of the faithful. After the pandemic, due to the smaller number of believers in our church. the annual income decreased significantly. According to statistics, there are currently about 400 fewer people in church every Sunday compared to the period before the pandemic, which also means lower Sunday contributions.
