THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

God uses numerous opportunities to reveal himself to a man. The gathering of the frightened disciples behind the doors of the Cenacle was an opportunity for Jesus to reveal himself as the Risen One. The meeting with the disciples gave Jesus the opportunity both to testify to the reality of His Person and to confirm that in His death and resurrection from the dead the words of the Scriptures and the prophets were fulfilled. The moment when the Lord "enlightened the minds of the disciples to understand the Scriptures" bore fruit in the Acts of the Apostles. Peter, by the grace of God, heals a man born lame. This miracle attracts a crowd of onlookers and listeners. Like Jesus once, Peter now uses this opportunity to proclaim to the people the Risen Jesus who fulfilled the Messianic prophecies. Listening to the word of God, let us open our hearts to meet the Lord.
