THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Today's celebration of Pentecost ends the Easter season. The descent of the Holy Spirit on those gathered in the Cenacle is another proof of God's love for sinful humanity. The Apostle Paul, through the words of today's second reading, will remind us what characterizes a person open to the action of the Spirit in his life. Let us ask the Lord during today's Eucharist to give us love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Endowed with these gifts, let us have the courage to testify before the world about our belonging to the Risen Jesus.

RENOVATION FUND

We are in the process of renovating the stairs to the church. The stairs are cracked, pieces of concrete are falling off, and most importantly, there is no water flow, ice forms in winter. Currently, the concrete surface is chipped off, poured with a new surface, which is then sanded and the appropriate glaze and varnish will be applied on it. The work is performed by a Polish company. After completing the work on the stairs, we will begin the process of washing all windows in the church, parish hall, Polish school rooms, parish offices and rectory. The stone facade of the church will also be washed. We can do this work thanks to your donations to the Renovation Fund.

Next Sunday, the second contribution will be collected for this fund and renovations that we want to carry out in the near future. We would like to thank all donors.
