## THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

The Old Testament provisions of the Law had many consequences. The discord appeared when the Law, instead of bringing pious Jews closer to God Yahweh and their neighbors, introduced unhealthy ritualism and distance in relationships between people. During the Last Supper, Jesus, pointing to the essence of the Law, gives his disciples a new commandment - the commandment of love. Only the one, who loves God and other people not with the letter, but with the heart, fulfills the essence of the commandment. When talking about love, Jesus was not talking about a strong feeling, but was pointing to himself. This is confirmed by the witness of that event, Saint John, who states in one of his letters: "God is love." Jesus himself showed an example of love up to the beams of the cross. In the Acts of the Apostles, this love drew the Gentiles to faith in Christ. Let us respond with love to the love of Jesus.

## DEVOTION TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY IN MAY

We have started May services, to which we invite you every day at 6:30 pm. This year, during services, we consider the history of the image, icon and devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help. What is the history of this beautiful devotion. Initially it was believed that May services began to be recited in the 18th century. Meanwhile, research by Mariologists showed that they were known much earlier, and in the East. Elsewhere, August was considered the month of Mary's Day, and prayers in honor of the Mother of God were even legally ordered in this month. In the East, the forerunners of May services were Coptic Christians. They met to pray around Marian statues, sang songs in choirs, and showered the

statue with flowers. Every Saturday the service was more solemn and obligatory for those who did not attend it every day. Apparently, the originator of this service was St. Cyril of Alexandria, an ardent defender of the divine motherhood of Mary.

The month of Mary was also known in the Holy Land, Greece and Syria, but it gained real popularity only at the turn of the 13th and 14th centuries. Why May? Because it is the most beautiful month of the year.

## PARENTS' ROSARY FOR CHILDREN

We are looking for 13 parents for the Holy Rosary Rose of John Paul II, which was founded in 2010, but currently only seven mothers come regularly to exchange rosary mysteries on the first Sunday of each month. The Parents'

Rosary is a faith community prayer based on the Living Rosary pattern. We pray by joining groups of 20 parents, called roses. A participant of the Parents' Rosary prays for his children and for the children of other members of a given rose, and in return, other parents from this rose pray for his children. Each parent prays one decade of the Rosarv every day with the mystery assigned to him for a given month. In this way, the entire rosary is recited every day for the children of that parent. We pray in any convenient place and time. It is best to choose a specific time during the day and incorporate this prayer into the rhythm of the day - after all, it is only 3-5 minutes of time. The exchange of rosary mysteries takes place every first Sunday of the month before the Holy Mass at 11:00. Parents who would like to join the Rose of the Rosary of John Paul II are asked to complete the form located at the back of the church and drop it in the mailbox at the parish office. Once we have collected 20 parents, the group leader, Bozena Zambrowicz, will contact the new members of the St. Rosary Rose of John Paul II.
