THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

Jewish oracles foretold the coming of the Messiah – the savior of the Chosen People. The authors of the Book of Isaiah perpetuated the image of the Servant of the Lord, who, subjected to suffering, would become a sacrificial victim. The Jews from the Gospel and even the Apostles themselves did not expect that it would be Jesus who would fulfill the ancient prophecies. The disciples had sacrificed too much for their master to be killed now. Peter steps forward and rebukes Jesus. Jesus calls Peter an adversary and orders him to get out of sight, that is, to withdraw to the rear, behind Jesus' back. The attempt to rebuke Jesus ends with Peter being reprimanded. The fulfillment of Jesus' mission is the sacrifice of the cross. A follower of Jesus is someone who takes up the cross. An adversary is someone who removes the cross from their life. May the word of God bring us closer to the Messiah., let us open our hearts to the word of God today.
