DONATION OR PACKAGE FOR FLOOD VICTIMS

Many parishes and Polish organizations are collecting funds to help our compatriots affected by the flood. Items should be packed in a box, written on the box what is in it, and delivered by Sunday, October 6 to the parish hall of one of the following parishes: St. Casimir in Toronto, St. Maximilian Kolbe in Mississauga, St. Eugene in Brampton, Sacred Heart of Jesus in Kitchener, St. Stanislaus in Hamilton, and St. Anthony in Oakville.
