THE PASTOR'S REFLECTION

For the ancient Jews, signs from heaven were the heralds of a new era. For Isaiah, a new era would soon come, when the wastelands of Edom would be covered with greenery, and the devastated Jerusalem would be rebuilt. Then "the ears of the deaf would be unstopped ... and the tongues of the dumb would shout for joy."

In accordance with the prophets' announcement, the advent of the messianic era was associated simultaneously with the coming of the Messiah. The Chosen People were to recognize God's Anointed One by the miraculous signs that he would perform among the people. The deeds of Christ testify that the Messiah is already present among people. The sign of Jesus' healing of the deaf-mute is a visual fulfillment of the sign from the Book of Isaiah. Looking at the example of Jesus, let us open our hearts to the word of God today.

On Wednesday, September 11, on the anniversary of the terrorist attacks in New York, we want to remember to pray for the victims of terror and totalitarian regimes, and for peace throughout the world, especially in Ukraine and the Holy Land, mutual understanding and respect for the nations of the world.

DEVOTION TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

This Friday, September 13, we invite you to the Fatima service at 6 pm. We bring battery-powered lanterns with us, candles are not allowed in the church. Fatima services are Marian services held on the 13th day of the month. This day is not accidental, because Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children, Saint. Jacinta, Saint Francis and Lucia, for 6 months from May 13, 1917 to October 13, 1917, Our Lady revealed three secrets to the children (commonly called the Secrets of Fatima). She also addressed the children with a request and message: "Pray the rosary every day." "I want you to continue to pray the rosary every day in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary, to ask for peace in the world and for an end to the war, because only She can obtain these graces."

FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

On Saturday, September 14, we will celebrate the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, commemorating the discovery of the relics of the cross on which our Lord Jesus Christ accomplished the salvation of the world. In times when the symbols of our faith are insulted, let us have the courage to admit that we are Christians, even by piously making the sign of the cross.
