JESUS CHRIST THE KING OF THE UNIVERSE Jesus is a unique King – he has no army or royal court, he does not wear a crown on his head or hold a golden scepter in his hand. On the last Sunday of the liturgical year, which is the feast of Jesus Christ the King of the Universe, we want to remind ourselves that true kingship is primarily connected with service. Jesus became King because he knew how to serve. Service is the ability to be for others and to give up oneself. Today's celebration was established almost a hundred years ago by the encyclical of Pius XI "Quas primas" and is the culmination of the entire liturgical year, during which we experience the entire mystery of salvation: we praise God and thank Him for the work of creation and redemption. Through holy baptism, we participate in this mystery and submit to the royal authority of Jesus Christ, who wants to unite us all in his kingdom of truth, peace and salvation.
