PASTOR'S REFLECTION

On Joy Sunday, once again in Lent, through the Liturgy of the Word, we experience the goodness of God and His love, which is revealed even by giving us more chances to convert. In the case of the first reading, the condition for joy was leaving the enslaving Egypt and celebrating Passover in the free Holy Land. However, the joy of this Sunday is deepened above all by the prodigal son, who is a representative of all of us – returning to God the Father after moments of infidelity. A loving God always makes it possible to return, although on one condition – personal conversion, the model of which we learn in the Gospel.

LAETARE SUNDAY

Today, the fourth Sunday of Lent is a little different from the others. In the tradition of the Church, we call it Laetare Sunday, or Sunday of joy. We can see this even in the change from the purple of Lent to the pink color of liturgical vestments.

In the middle of Lent, the Church calls the faithful to joy, so that all those who undertake the effort of a change of heart may persevere in this difficult daily effort.

SHARE LIFE

Today, there will be a second collection for ShareLife.

ShareLife - more than an annual campaign - it is a way to reach out to those in need! Every year, thousands of people turn to ShareLife agencies for help. These agencies provide services in an environment of Catholic values, carrying the Gospel message to those living on the margins. When we support ShareLife, we do more than just give; we show that the Catholic community is actively involved in social services in our archdiocese. Next Sunday will be the first collection for ShareLife. Our parish has been obliged with raising \$18,000 for ShareLife this year. Last year, we raised \$16,272.

The Polish Pope taught us by his own example, throughout the long years of his pontificate how to give ourselves completely to Christ and how to bear witness to faith. Let us try to imitate him in this.

Easter confession with the participation of many priests in our parish will take place on Palm Sunday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

RENOVATION OF THE CHURCH PEWS

By decision of the Finance Committee, we have decided to renovate the pews in our church. The direct reason for deciding to renovate the pew tops is their damaged varnish due to the use of disinfectants during the pandemic. The renovation will consist of completely removing the old varnish from the wooden tops of each pew. After thorough cleaning, the pews will be re-varnished. During the renovation, several pews will

be removed from the church and the renovation will be carried out in the AA group room downstairs under the church. A Polish company will do the work and the cost of restoring all the pews in the church, except the choir and kneelers, is \$55,000. All donations collected for the Renovation Fund are used to restore the pews. Last weekend, the second collection for restoring the pews in the church amounted to \$10,492. We sincerely thank all donors. God bless you for your generosity!
