**THE SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART

This coming Friday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of the Lord Jesus. This day is also celebrated as the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. Let us remember in our prayers the priests and pastors whose sacramental ministry we benefit from and who are our guides on the path to salvation. This coming Friday, for the pious and public recitation of the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of the Lord Jesus, one can gain a plenary indulgence on the usual conditions. These are: a state of sanctifying grace, lack of attachment to sin, even venial, receiving Holy Communion, and praying for the intentions designated by the Pope.

On the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of the Lord Jesus, abstinence from meat is not required.

RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH PEWS

Work is underway on a thorough renovation of the pews in our church. The pews are original and over 70 years old. The renovation involves completely removing the old varnish from the wooden tops of each pew. After thorough cleaning, the pews are varnished several times. The work is being done by a Polish company and the cost of renovating all the pews in the church, except for the choir and kneelers, is \$55,000 plus taxes. All donations collected for the Renovation Fund are intended for the renovation of the pews. To date, we have collected \$34,425. for the renovation of the pews. From the bottom of our hearts, we thank all donors. God bless you for your generosity! We extend special thanks to the Friends of the Oblate Missions for their donation of \$500. At the same time, we turn to you with a great request to take care of our common good, to make sure that children do not write on the pews or scratch them. We shouldn't stick gum to life under the benches, we often do that unfortunately. Let's respect the common good and our sacrifices!
