**OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL**

On Wednesday, July 16, in the liturgy we commemorate the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel and the history of the scapular, which dates back to the 12th century. It was on Mount Carmel (northwestern Israel) that the spiritual sons of the prophet Elijah led a fervent life of prayer. Due to persecution, they moved to Europe and gave rise to a new order – the Carmelites, which has become part of the history and spiritual face of the Church. The saints who were born of the Carmelite orders are among the most popular. This group includes Saint Teresa of the Child Jesus, and among Poles, Saint Rafał Kalinowski is well-known.

On this day, let us also remember our Pastor, who celebrates his birthday on this beautiful day. Fr. Janusz is on vacation, but let us surround him with our prayers.

The commemoration of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel reminds us of another important feature of Christian spirituality, namely the scapular. Our Lady revealed it to Simon

Stock, General of the Carmelites in Cambridge (England), in 1251. She also promised anyone who would wear it until death that they would not experience the fires of hell or any other danger. Today, many of us wear scapular medals. Let us take care that it is not just a decoration of our attire. Let it be a sign of our religiousness, worn with faith and love. Let us also pray to Our Lady that we may arrive happily at our Mount Carmel, which is Christ. Like Mary, let us listen to the word of God, let us meditate on it and keep it in our hearts.

**RESTORATION OF THE CHURCH PEWS**

Work is underway on a thorough renovation of the pews in our church. The pews are original and over 70 years old. The renovation involves completely removing the old varnish from the wooden tops of each pew. After thorough cleaning, the pews are varnished several times. The work is being done by a Polish company and the cost of renovating all the pews in the church, except for the choir and kneelers, is \$55,000 plus taxes. All donations collected for the Renovation Fund are intended for the renovation of the pews. To date, we have collected \$38,425. We thank Krystyna & Eugeniusz Cudek for the donation of \$3,000. From the bottom of our hearts, we thank all donors. God bless you for your generosity! We decided to also renovate the kneelers, at least the ones by the renovated pews. On the left side of the church we have 88 kneelers, which means 4 in each pew. The cost of renovating one kneeler is \$110, which means \$9,680 for 88 kneelers. We will renovate the kneelers in July. Work on renovating the remaining pews will resume after the Polish Festival in Roncessvalles, which is in mid-September.
