POLISH ALTAR IN MIDLAND

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs and the 70th anniversary of Polish pilgrimages to Midland. Fifty-three years ago, in 1973, the Polish Altar was built thanks to donations from the Polish community. Unfortunately, for safety reasons, the altar had to be dismantled, and we are in the process of building a new Polish altar. The altar will be completed in time for the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which will take place on Sunday, August 9, and will be consecrated by Archbishop Tadeusz Wojda, President of the Polish Episcopal Conference. The project cost \$65,000. We would like to thank everyone who donated last Sunday for the construction of a new altar; we collected a total of \$7,400 in our parish.
