WORLD YOUTH DAY IN SOUTH KOREA

Our parish is organizing a trip to the 41st World Youth Day in Seoul, South Korea, which will take place from August 3-8, 2027. The event's theme will be "Courage! I have overcome the world!" These words are taken from Jesus' farewell discourse to his disciples in the Gospel of John. Young people interested in the trip are asked to contact Father Paweł. Over 4,000 young Poles have already declared their participation in World Youth Day in Seoul in 2027. The largest number of applications come from the two Warsaw dioceses and the Archdioceses of Krakow and Gdańsk.

PILGRIMAGE TO THE SHRINE OF CANADIAN MARTYRS IN MIDLAND

The Polish Priests' Conference for Eastern Canada cordially invites its compatriots to the 70th Pilgrimage of the Polish Community in Ontario to the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs in Midland, which will take place on Sunday, August 9, 2026. This year's celebration will be led by the President of the Polish Episcopal Conference, Archbishop Tadeusz Wojda of Gdańsk. During the ceremony, a new Polish Altar will be dedicated.

Program of the indulgence ceremonies: 10:30 AM - Rosary; 11:15 AM - Entrance of the walking pilgrimage; 11:30 AM - Solemn Mass of the indulgence; 1:00 PM - Devotion, blessing of herbs and flowers.

We ask pilgrims to go to confession in their own parishes. Due to the small number of priests participating in the ceremonies, it will not be possible to receive the sacrament of reconciliation. Father Janusz Błazejak OMI, President of the Conference of Polish Priests.

POLISH ALTAR IN MIDLAND

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs and the 70th anniversary of Polish pilgrimages to Midland. In 1956, to celebrate the Marian Year, the 300th anniversary of the defense of Jasna Gora, and the vows of King John, the first nationwide Polish pilgrimage to Midland was organized. Fifty-three years ago, in 1973, the Polish Altar was built thanks to donations from the Polish community. Unfortunately, the altar is completely rotten. After consultation, the Conference of Polish Priests decided to build a new altar. The new altar will retain the same characteristics as the previous one. The old altar has already been demolished, and the new foundations and bench have been poured.

The new altar will be completed in time for this year's celebration of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which will take place on August 9th. It will be consecrated by Archbishop Tadeusz Wojda, President of the Polish Episcopal Conference, who will preside over the main ceremonies in Midland. The total cost of the project is \$80,000. Parishioners
