THE PASTOR’S REFLECTION

What does true hospitality mean? The Word of God shows that openness of heart toward others is also openness to God. In the first reading, the woman welcomes the prophet Elisha with great generosity. This is an expression of her respect and openness to God's presence. Her gesture is not mere courtesy, but a testimony of profound faith. In the Letter to the Romans, St. Paul says that through baptism we are immersed in the death and resurrection of Christ, which becomes an invitation to a life of love. In this way, we open our hearts to God, sharing Him with others. The Gospel emphasizes that welcoming the Apostles is welcoming Christ Himself. Every gesture of hospitality, even the smallest, has great value in God's eyes, because through this gesture we express our faithfulness and love for Him.

WORLD YOUTH DAY IN SOUTH KOREA

Our parish is organizing a trip to the 41st World Youth Day in Seoul, South Korea, which will take place from August 3-8, 2027. The event's theme will be “Courage! I have overcome the world!” These words are taken from Jesus’ farewell discourse to his disciples in the Gospel of John. Young people interested in the trip are asked to contact Father Paweł. Over 4,000 young Poles have already declared their participation in World Youth Day in Seoul in 2027. The largest number of applications come from the two Warsaw dioceses and the Archdioceses of Krakow and Gdańsk.

The Polish Priests’ Conference for Eastern Canada cordially invites its compatriots to the 70th Pilgrimage of the Polish Community in Ontario to the Shrine of the Canadian Martyrs in Midland, which will take place on Sunday, August 9, 2026. This year's celebration will be led by the President of the Polish Episcopal Conference, Archbishop Tadeusz Wojda of Gdańsk. During the ceremony, a new Polish Altar will be dedicated.

Program of the indulgence ceremonies: 10:30 AM - Rosary; 11:15 AM - Entrance of the walking pilgrimage; 11:30 AM - Solemn Mass of the indulgence; 1:00 PM - Devotion, blessing of herbs and flowers.
